

RESOLUTION NO. 18-036
AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN FIRE DISTRICT PROPERTY
IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36

WHEREAS, the Harrison Township Fire District #1 ("Fire District") has acquired new SCBA equipment which has replaced the Fire District's existing SCBA equipment inventory (the "Old SCBA Inventory") which is identified on the inventory list attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Old SCBA Inventory, on average, still has approximately two years of useful life before it can no longer serve its intended purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Fire District has determined that the Old SCBA Inventory cannot be sold for use by other fire protection companies and has only minimal sale or scrap value on the open market; and

WHEREAS, the Fire District desires to dispose of the Old SCBA Inventory in a manner that allows the SCBA equipment to be used through the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that emergency services personnel in the United Fire Department, 6490 Horton Hwy, Baileyton Tennessee can utilize the Old SCBA Inventory; and

WHEREAS, while the disposition of personal property owned by a public entity generally must be achieved through sale by open public bidding or public auction, a contracting unit may sell public property no longer needed for public use without advertising for bids when the sale is to another government unit within the United States pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:12-21.1 authorize the private sale of such public property for nominal amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Harrison Township Fire District #1 that the Old SCBA Inventory identified on the inventory list attached hereto as Exhibit "A" shall be sold to emergency services personnel in the United Fire Department, 6490 Horton Hwy, Baileyton Tennessee for the sum of \$1.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Kenneth Powell, and/or the Fire District Business Administrator, Brian Bartholomew, be and are hereby authorized to take all necessary action to implement this resolution, including without limitation the execution of any and all documents necessary in connection herewith.
